The OCAC is committed to exhibiting diverse forms of art, particularly art from the Oxford Region. Annually there are individual and group artist's exhibitions with artists selected by a committee. Originality is of the highest priority and suitability for the space will necessarily also be a consideration. The OCAC exhibition space consists of three areas: 41 linear ft. gallery; hall with 86 linear ft. and an open "parlor" space with 41 linear ft.

The 19th century building was originally built as the Oxford College for Women. The 1990's saw the beginning of a collaborative community project to restore the structure making it a center for visual and performing arts.
